Mr. COUDERT (by request) introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Declaring the 14th day of June 1952 the one hundred and seventy-fifth anniversary of the adoption of the flag of the United States, to be a legal public holiday, and authorizing the President to issue a proclamation in commemoration thereof.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That in order to honor the one hundred and seventy-fifth anni-
4 versary of the adoption of the flag of the United States, the
5 14th day of June, known as Flag Day, is, for the year 1952
6 only, made a legal public holiday to all intents and purposes
7 and in the same manner as the 1st day of January, the
8 22^a day of February, the 30th day of May, the 4th day of

1 July, the first Monday of September, the 11th day of No-
2 vember, the fourth Thursday of November, and Christmas
3 Day.

4 SEC. 2. The President of the United States is hereby
5 authorized to issue a proclamation, honoring such one hun-
6 dred and seventy-fifth anniversary, and calling upon officials
7 of the Government to *display the flag of the United States on*
8 the 14th day of June 1952, and inviting the people of the
9 United States to observe the day in schools and churches or
10 other suitable places, with appropriate ceremonies.
