A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR.

June 14, 1927, will be the 150th anniversary of the adoption of the American Flag.

This sesqui-centennial event in our history deserves general public recognition and, with the cooperation of patriotic societies, fraternal orders, civic, educational and religious bodies, and other organizations throughout the United States, plans are being made for a nation-wide celebration to be known as "American Patriot Week."

The people of Idaho are ever ready to express their love for the Flag of our country and their devotion to all that it represents.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Idaho, I do hereby designate the week of June 8-14, 1927

FLAG WEEK

and do proclaim Tuesday, June 14, 1927

FLAG DAY

taking this opportunity to make an earnest appeal to the head of every home in Idaho to purchase the Flag of our nation, and on all public holidays, especially this year during FLAG WEEK, to display the same at some conspicuous place on the outside of the home; as well as having it appear on all public official and business buildings.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be affixed the Great Seal of the State of Idaho, this 10th day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.
