

PROCLAMATION

I, Sam. A. Baker, Governor of Missouri, do hereby designate as Flag Day, Tuesday the 14th day of June of the present year, and ask that the people of this State display the American Flag and in every way possible show honor and respect for it and the principles for which it stands.

It is a symbol of freedom and truth; of strength, bravery, justice, happiness, loyalty and liberty. Every day of the three hundred and sixty five should be Flag Day, but conforming to a custom, as well as an act of Congress designating this particular day as Flag Day, I am hereby issuing this Proclamation, trusting that the people of the State will observe it, in letter and in spirit.

Given under my Hand and the seal of the State, at the Capitol in Jefferson City, this Ninth day of June, in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Seven.
