PROCLAMATION

BY THE

Governor of the State of Texas

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

Pursuant to wide-spread custom, a majority of the states of the Union join in the annual observation of a week dedicated to the American Flag.

The reverence and pride in which Old Glory is held by every loyal and patriotic American citizen scarcely requires a reminder of the ideals and traditions for which it stands. Yet that Texans, who have lived under six flags, and whose loyalty to the National emblem is unquestioned, might join hands with patriotic citizens of other States in this observance;

I, Dan Moody, Governor of Texas, hereby proclaim June 8- 14 as

F L A G W E E K

and urge all of our citizens to honor the flag and uphold its ideals. Moreover, it would be fitting if the flag were everywhere unfurled, especially on public buildings, during the observance of this commemoration, and I so recommend.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto signed my name and caused the Seal of State to be affixed at the City of Austin, this the 7th day of June, A D 1927.
